




Assistive Technology Language Assessment Primary

Have you ever tried to assess a student with little or no speech? With many tests it is almost impossible, but now with today's technology many new avenues have been made available for use in testing.

Assessment is an informal assessment designed to assess skills such as syntax, semantics, auditory association, and auditory processing. Unlike other standard assessments this assessment is geared specifically toward those students needing an alternative method of communication and/or access. Using Mayer Johnson's picture communication symbols as well as their augmenta-

Dynamically boards have been put together to form a thorough on screen interactive assessment of a child's early language skills.

For younger and more physically challenged students the test has also been adapted for use with the **Intellikeys Adaptive Keyboard**. 93 overlays were designed to perform the same function as the interactive version mentioned above. Complete with flashcards this form of the assessment can be used and accessed by hand or through alter-

native access such as head pointers.

Subtests, complete with forms, were designed to measure receptive and expressive language skills, to identify strengths and weaknesses in language and to measure a students ability to understand and communicate through pictures. The test gives students audio feedback as well as in many cases a voice with which to answer questions. Although the audio feedback is not necessary for all students it provides a verbal reinforcement that allows students to achieve and answer questions more accurately.






Weekly Journals







Boardmaker Academic Examples
