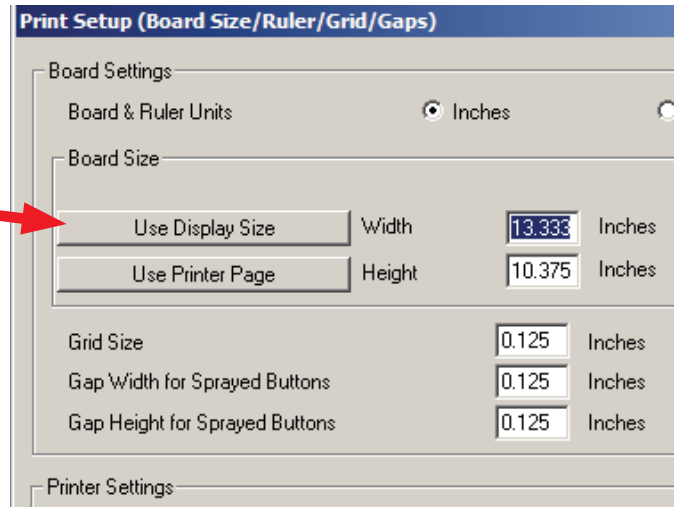
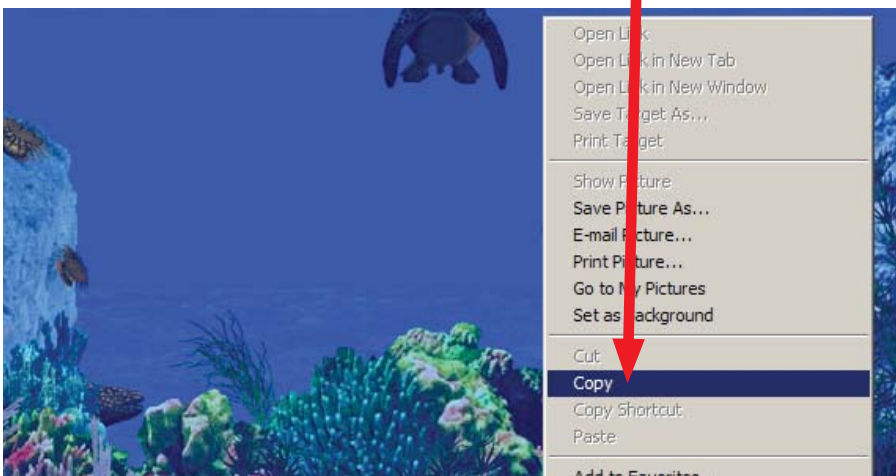


Boardmaker Plus - Find the Hidden Picture

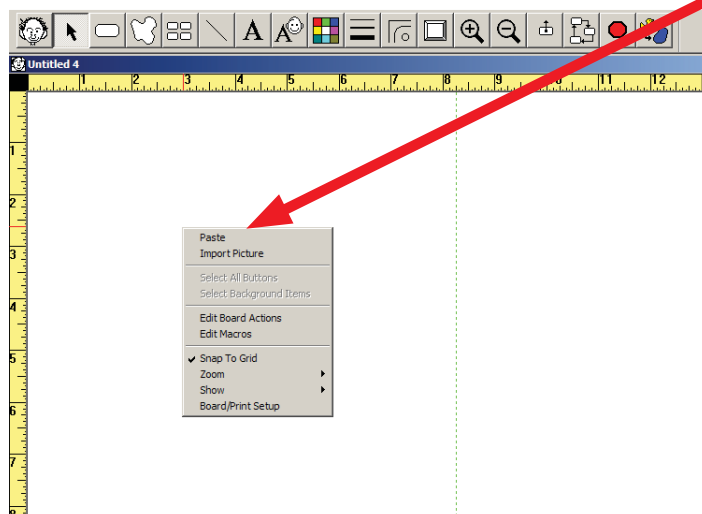
1. Click **File** and **New Board**
2. Click **File** and **Print Setup**
3. Click **Use Display Size**
4. Click **OK**



5. Next go to the Internet and find a picture for the background.
 - a. Right click on picture and drag down to **Copy**



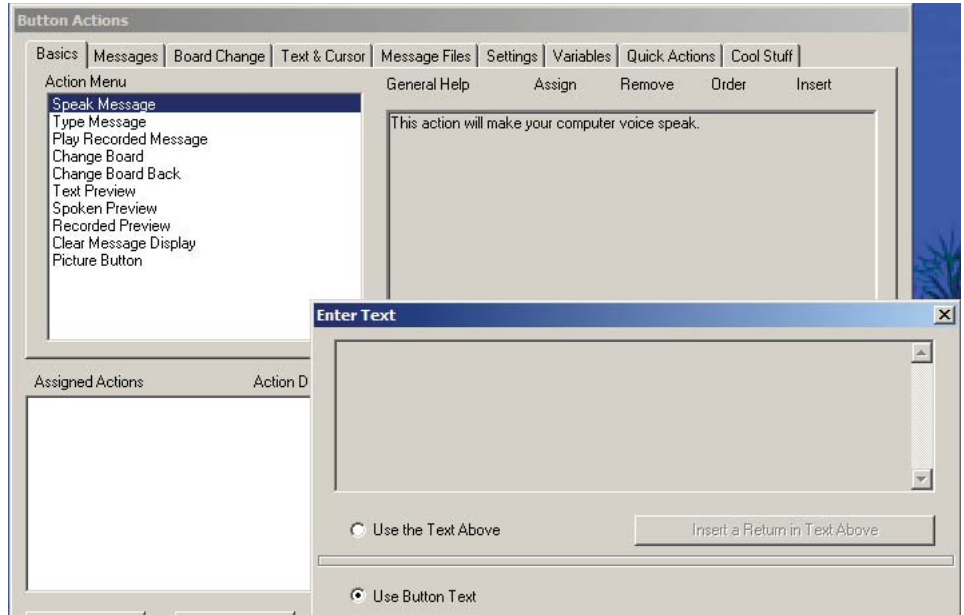
- b. in Boardmaker Right click on the background and drag down to **Paste**



6. Create 1 button at the bottom of the picture you pasted.

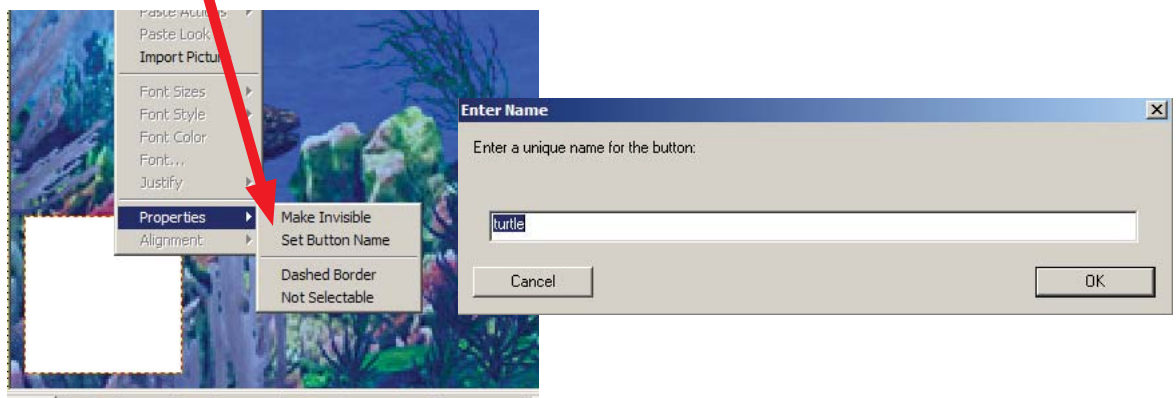
7. Double click on the new button

- a. Click **Speak Message**
- b. Click the **Use Button Text** radio button
- c. Click Ok

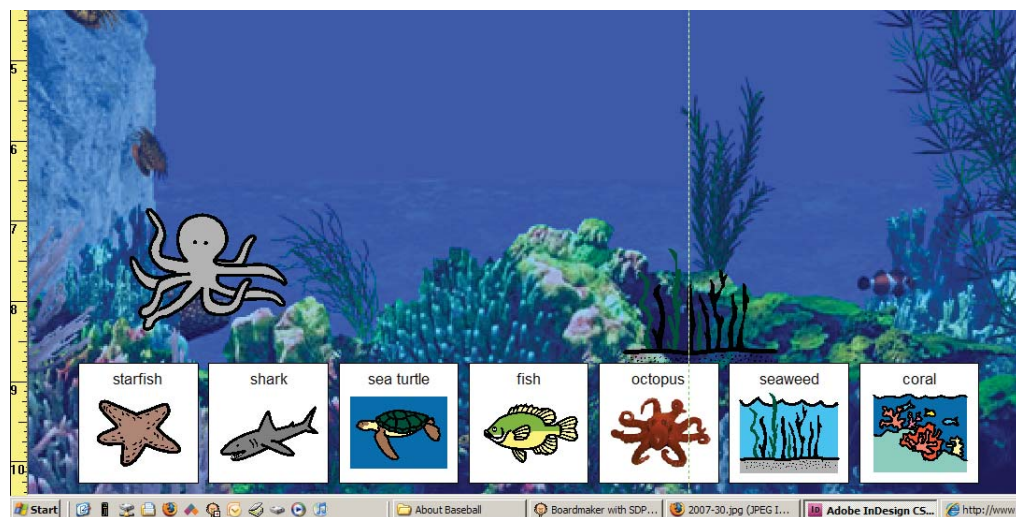


8. Right click on the button

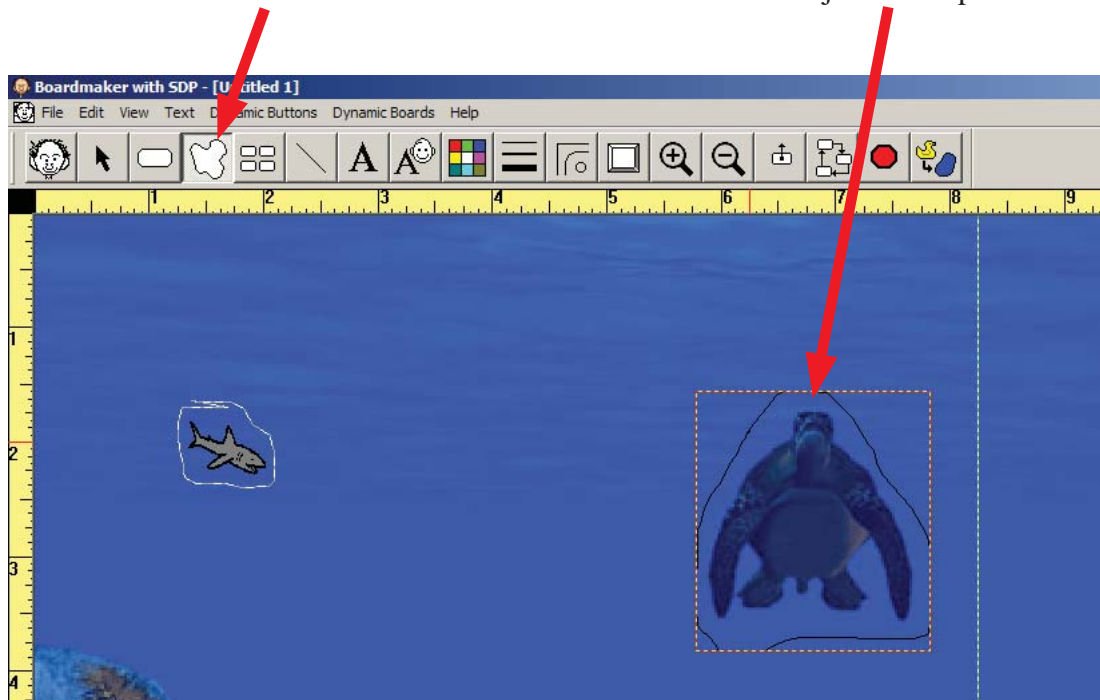
- a. Click **Set Button Name**
- b. Click OK
- c. Type in the button name and click OK



9. Use the **Button Sprayer Tool** to duplicate the blank button and fill in the button with pictures as seen below.



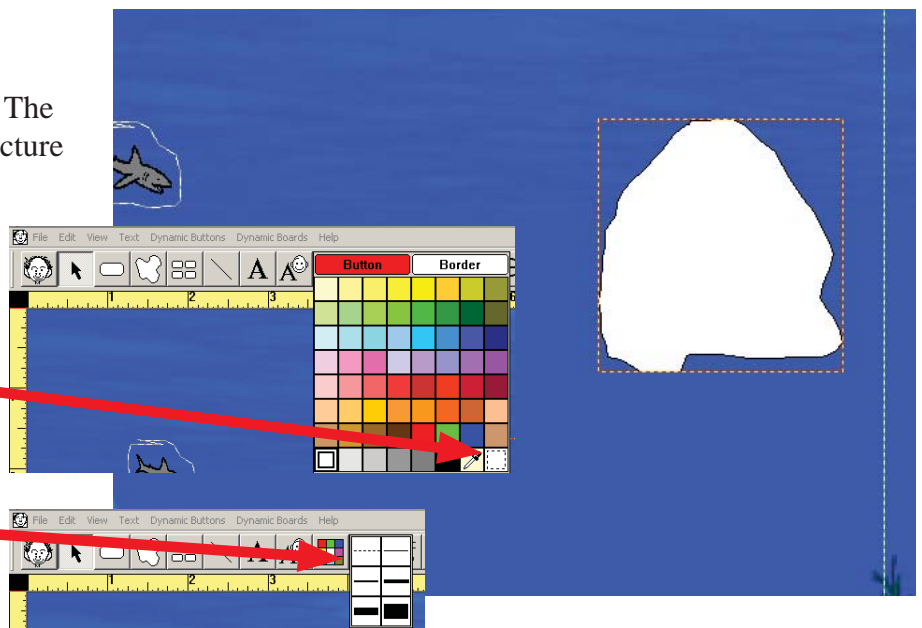
10. Click the **Freeform Button Tool** and draw a line around an object in the picture.



11. Single click on the button you drew. The button may be white and not show the picture behind it.

- Click the color palette on the toolbar
- choose the bottom right color which is transparent.

- Click the line thickness tool on the toolbar which and drag down to the dotted line.



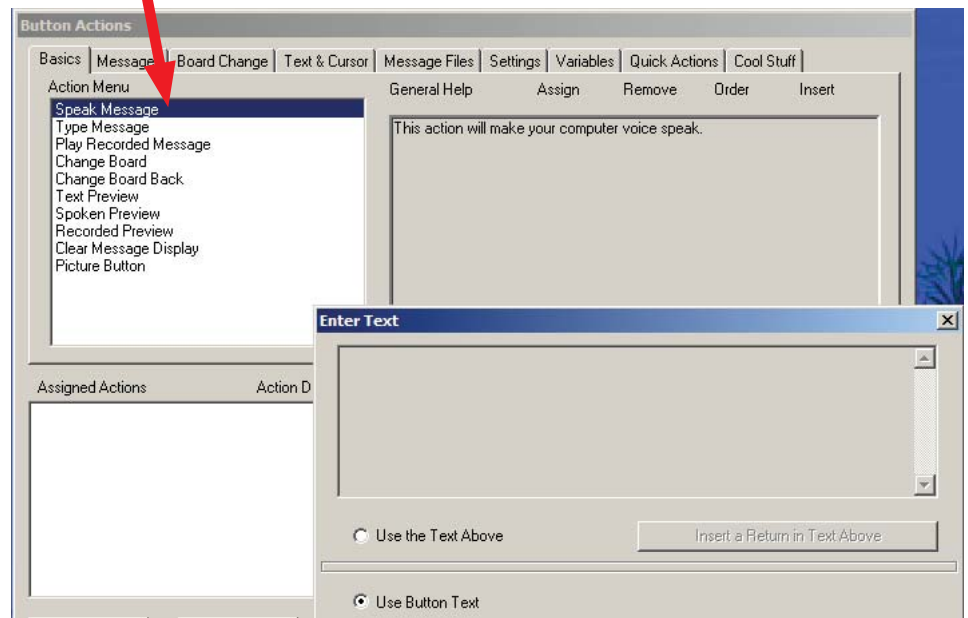
d. **THE STEPS ABOVE WILL MAKE THE BUTTON INVISIBLE**

12. Double click on the button to add features to it

a. Click **Speak Message**

b. Type "Great you found the sea turtle."

c. Click OK



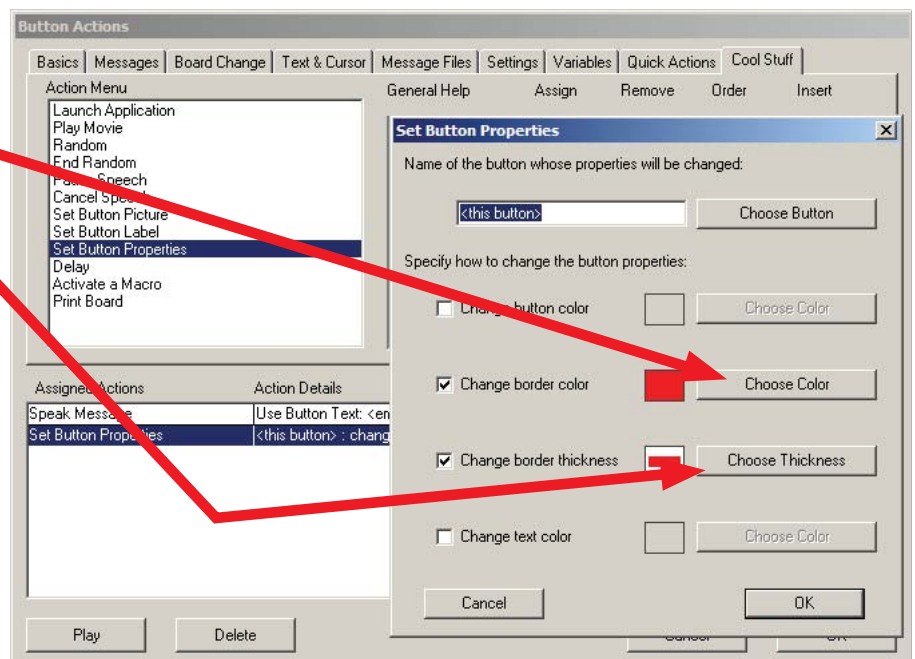
d. Click the **Cool Stuff** tab

e. Click **Set Button Properties**

f. Change border color

g. Change border thickness

h. Click OK

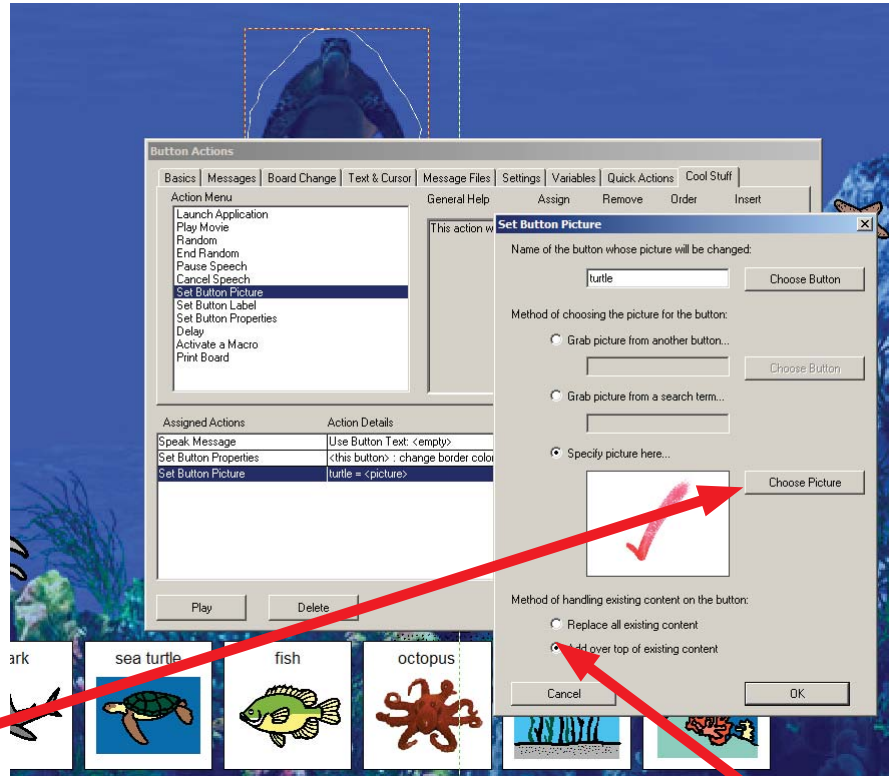

j. Click **Set Button Properties**

k. Click **Choose Button**

and click on the button on the bottom toolbar that goes with the picture selected. (example - if you lassoed the turtle click on the turtle on the bottom toolbar.



l. Click **Choose Button** next to the **Specify Picture Here** radio button.

m. search for a picture to use for the check mark. If you do not have one you may have to copy one from the internet and paste into the library before you do this step.

n. Click the **Add over top of existing content** radio button

o. Click OK

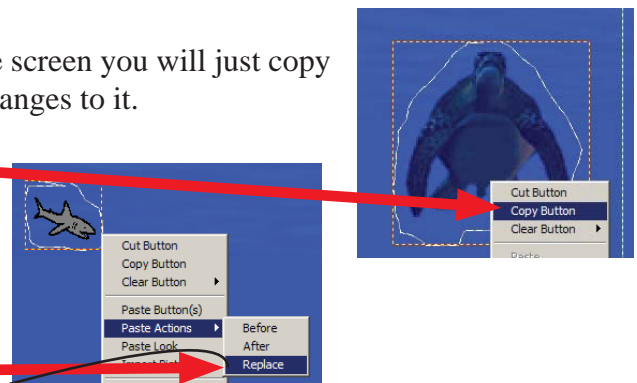
13. For the rest of the button you draw around objects on the screen you will just copy and paste the fetures of the button above and make minor changes to it.

a. Right click on button and click **Copy Button**

b. Draw a new button

c. Right click on the new button and drag down to **Paste Actions - Replace**

d. Change the content to reflect the button you are working on



Example - Set Button Picture is changed from turtle to shark
Example - Speak Message is now great you found the shark

Assigned Actions	Action Details
Speak Message	great job you found the shark
Set Button Properties	<this button> : change border color, bord
Set Button Picture	shark = <picture>
