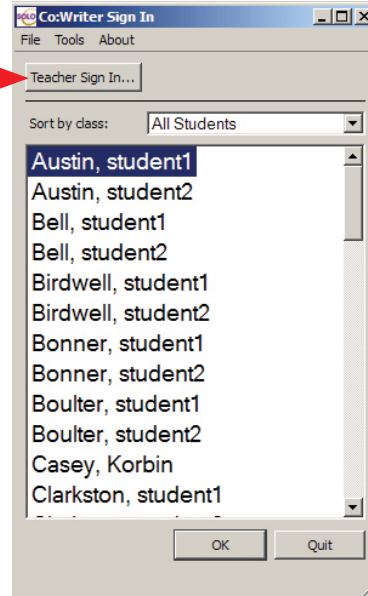


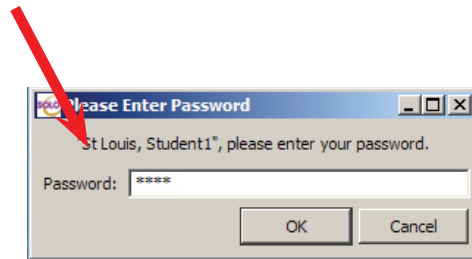
Cowriter Solo

I. Basic Program Use

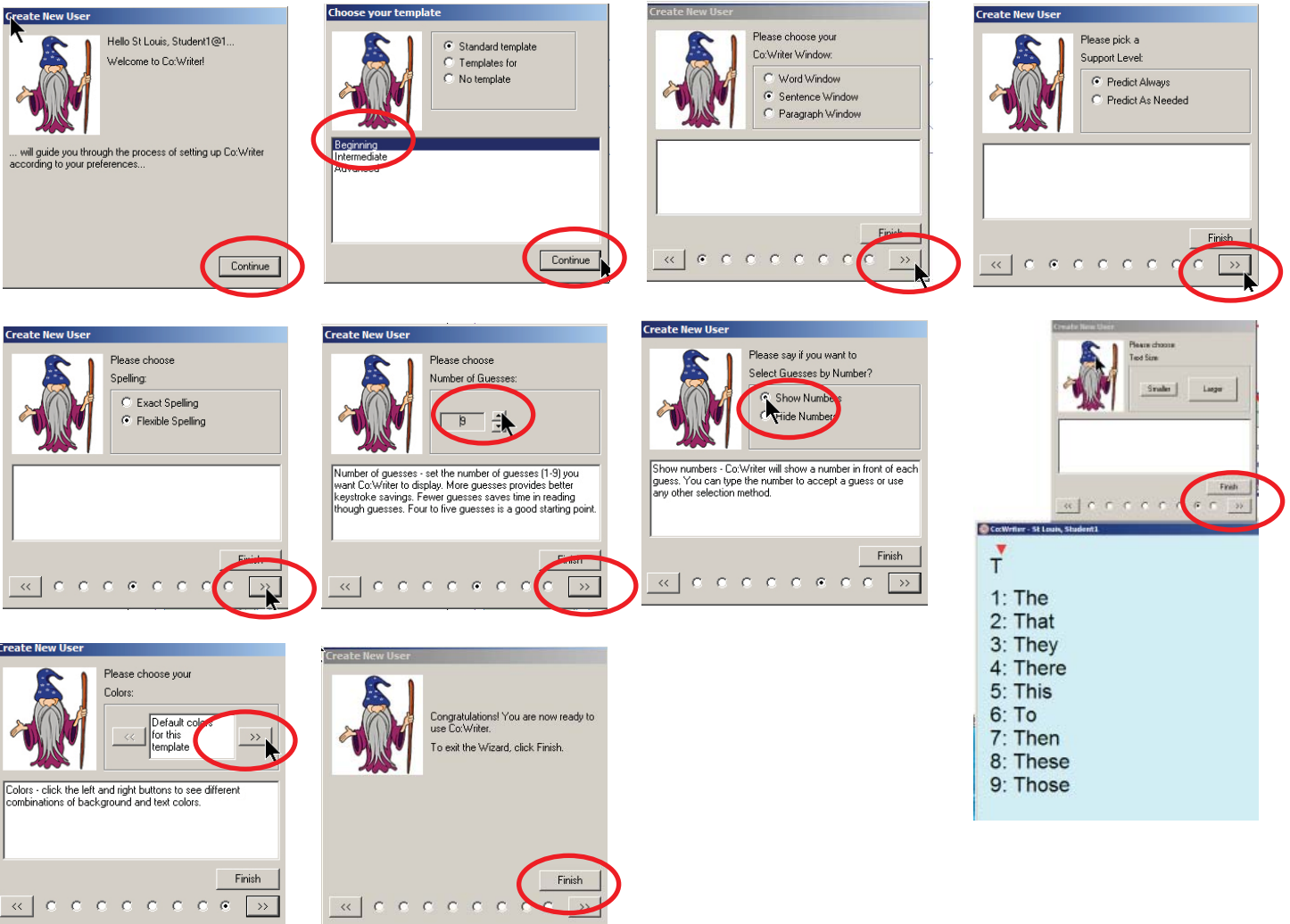
1. Click on student name



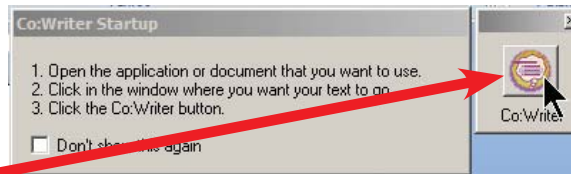
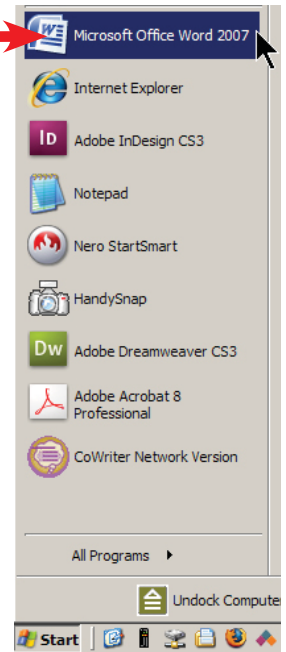
2. Type password (tisd)



3. Click through student setup one time.

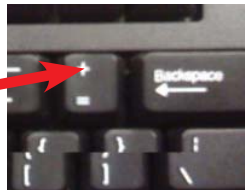


4. Open a word processor (Microsoft Word or other)



5. Click **CoWriter** icon.

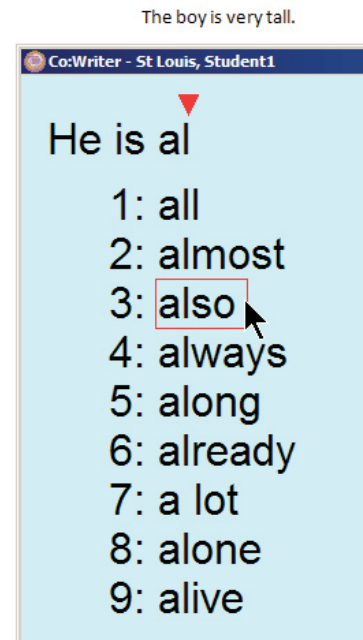
or press +/- key on keyboard



6. Type first letter of word you wish to type.

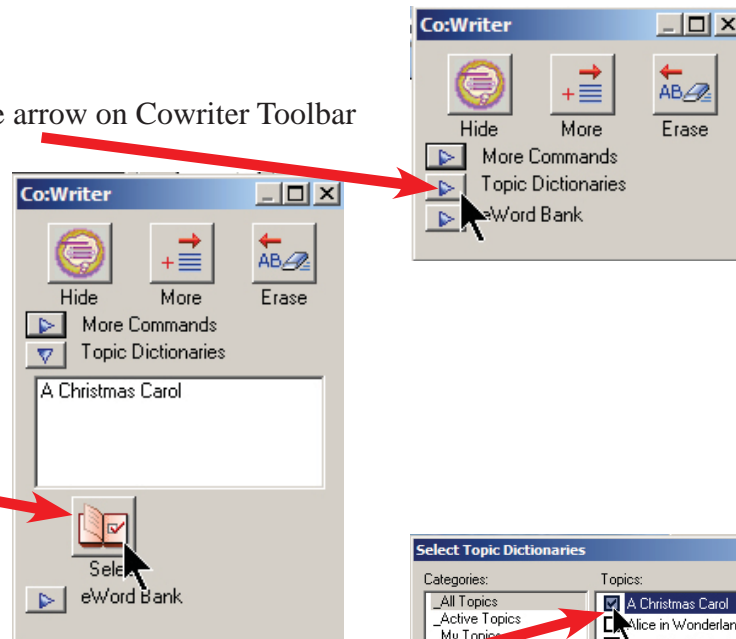
7. Review the list of words to see if the word you wish to type is listed.

8. If student cannot read the word they may pass over word with the mouse and it will be read to them.



II. Using Topic Dictionaries - (These are specific dictionaries of words used to further improve prediction for the students when writing. For example: When doing a book report on Harry Potter a student might want to use a Harry Potter Topic Dictionary so words such as Harry Potter appear in the list of words.)

1. Click Topic Dictionary blue arrow on Cowriter Toolbar

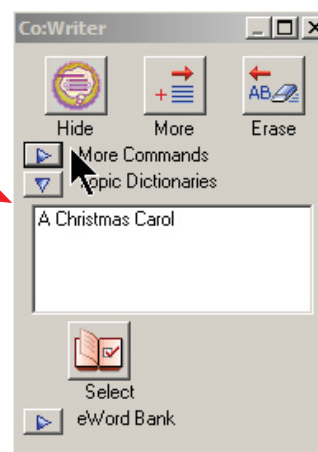
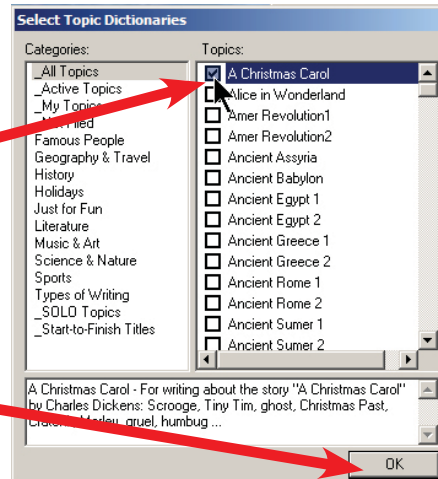


2. Click Select

3. choose the Dictionary in the list you wish to use.

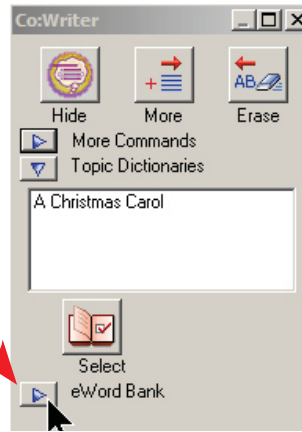
4. Click **OK**.

5. Cowriter Toolbar will then show dictionary you have chosen listed.

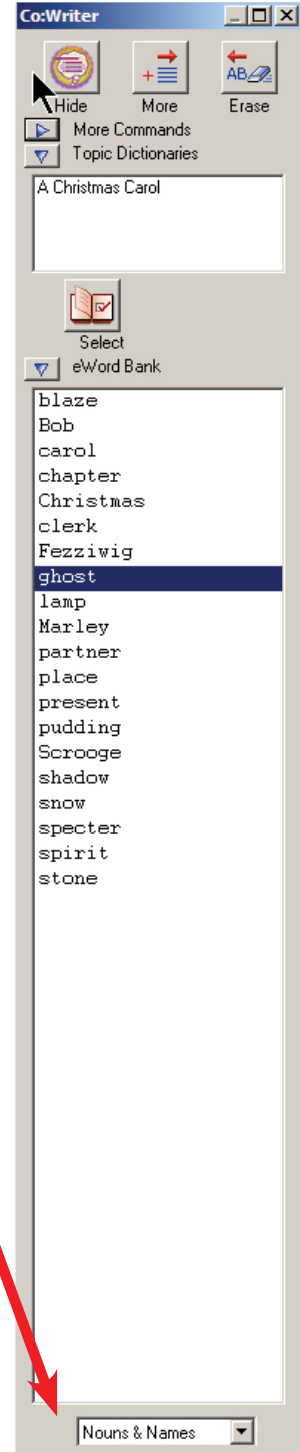


III. eWord Bank Use

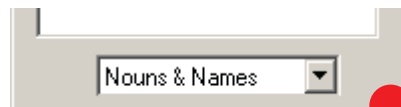
1. Click blue arrow for eWordBank



2. A word bank of words dealing with that specific Topic Dictionary will be displayed to help students choose words for their writing.



3. At the bottom of the word bank is a category list to allow students to choose parts of speech to be shown in the list.



4. Double Clicking on a word will read the word to the student aloud.
