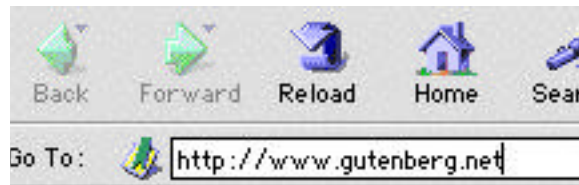


Getting an E-Text from the Internet

1. Open your browser (Netscape or internet explorer)

2. Type in the location
(<http://www.gutenberg.net>)



3. Click on search



4. Type in the name of the author or book you are looking for:
